Local Rules

1. USGA rules will govern all play, including the following.
2. **Embedded ball** – Embedded ball rule is in effect in the general area. Lift, clean, and drop as near as possible. Exceptions to the rule are that relief is not given in penalty areas, sand bunkers, or when the ball is embedded in sand in part of the general area that is not cut to fairway height or less.
3. **Out of Bounds** – Will be defined by white stakes and includes the homeowner's side of water hazards and the interior edge of streets, even if your ball comes to rest on the golf course beyond the interior edge.
4. **Local Rule for Out of Bounds or Lost Ball** – if a ball comes to rest out of bounds or is deemed lost a player may take relief from the position where your ball went out of bounds or is likely to be lost. Proceed to the nearest fairway edge no closer to the hole and drop within the cone of relief not to extend past 2 club lengths into the fairway. 2 stroke penalty.
5. All cart paths are immovable obstructions and eligible for relief.
6. All bulkheads are considered integral parts of the golf course and no relief is given.
7. **Fixed sprinkler head** – when your line of play is interfered by a sprinkler head that is within two club-lengths of the green and two club-lengths of your ball, nearest point of relief can be taken.
8. If a ball strikes a 150-yard pole it is considered “rub of the green,” and will be played as it lies.
9. **Creek Course #10** – The driving range left of hole #10 is a No Play Penalty Zone. You must abandon your ball and utilize the nearest drop zone no closer to the hole (1 stroke penalty) or return to the tee for stroke and distance relief.

Safety Protocol

1. **Lightning:** Intermittent Siren - Stop play and seek shelter. Continuous Siren - Safe to resume play. Strobe Light: Amber (Caution) - Lightning detected between 5 and 20 miles. White (Alarm) - Lightning detected inside of 5 miles..
2. **Emergencies:** Call 911 first, then the pro shop 597-2900.

General Information

1. Established USGA pace of play is four hours. As a courtesy “if there is an open hole in front of any group, that group must allow a faster following group to play through.”(Club Rule 6.4b).
2. Pace of play will be monitored by rangers. Rangers are expected to implement pace of play in a non-confrontational and courteous manner. Members are expected to treat them with cooperation and respect.
3. Keep carts on cart paths and in natural areas whenever possible. Observe the 90 degree rule.
4. Carts must remain on the cart path on Par 3s at all times.
5. Please properly repair ball marks, sand divots, and rake bunkers, leave the course better than you found it.
