

Hiestand tied for lead at Florida Senior Women's Open

Naples amateur Mary Jane Hiestand of Hideout Country Club heads into the final round of the Florida Senior Women's Open in perfect position to win.

Hiestand is tied with Susan Bond of PGA Magazine with a five-over-par 149 during the first two days of the event at Quail Creek Country Club, which concludes Sunday.

Hiestand shot a three-over 75, following her 74 on Friday.

Bond, who at the turn led by five strokes, tumbled to a five-over 77.

Bonita Springs' Kim Keyer-Scott is just one stroke back at 150, with Paula Brzostowski two shots back.

In the Florida Women's Open, Sandra Angulo Minarro fired a four-under 68 to grab a two-shot lead over Guro Rambjoer, Sandra Changkija and Jessy Tang.

Former St. John Neumann golfer Sydner Shrader, now at North Florida, made a move into the top 10, firing a one-under 71 to land at 145, six shots off

the pace and tied for tenth.

Naples amateur Emma Bradley, a Baylor commit, is tied for 27th and 11 shots off the pace after shooting a four-over 76 Saturday.

Cape Coral resident Gabriella Wheeler is tied for 15th at 148, nine shots back.

Among the other local players making the cut was Estero senior Kim Egozi, who completed her round with a six-over 78, putting her at nine-over for the tournament and 14 shots back, tied for 43rd.
